

PRIVACY POLICY

Dear Data Subject, we would like to inform you that “*Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data*” (henceforth “GDPR”) stipulates that the protection of natural persons concerning the processing of their personal data is a fundamental right. In accordance with Article 13 of the GDPR, we therefore inform you that:

1. **CATEGORIES OF DATA:** **Perissinotto SPA** will process your personal data as follows:
2. Automatically collected data. Computer systems and applications used in the operation of this website detect, in the course of their normal operation, certain data (whose transmission is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols) which could potentially be associated with identifiable users. Such data includes the IP addresses and domain names of computers used by visitors to the website, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of any request made, the time of the request, the method used to forward the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error etc) and other parameters concerning the user’s operating system, browser and digital environment. This data is processed for the time strictly necessary and for the sole purpose of gaining statistical information regarding use of the website and to verify its correct operation. The provision of such data is obligatory, since it is directly connected to the web browsing experience.
3. Data provided voluntarily by the user. The explicit and voluntary sending of emails to the addresses indicated for this website’s various channels of access does not constitute a request for consent, and the completion of specific forms entails the subsequent acquisition of the user/sender’s email address and data, which are necessary in order to respond to requests arising and/or to deliver the requested service. The voluntary sending by you of emails to our email addresses does not require any further information or requests for consent. On the contrary, summaries of specific information will appear or be seen on website pages used to request particular services (forms). The user must therefore give explicit consent to the use of data provided in such forms in order to send the request.
4. Cookies. This website uses cookies. Data collected by cookies may be used to access parts of the website, for statistical purposes or to make the browsing experience more efficient and enjoyable in the future, by monitoring the behaviour of users and altering the provision of content accordingly. For further information, please consult the dedicated cookie policy.
5. **SOURCES OF PERSONAL DATA:** Personal data held by **Perissinotto SPA** is collected directly from the data subject.

7. **CONTACT DETAILS OF THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER:** The data controller is not obliged to provide details of the DPO.
8. **PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING:** The legal basis for the processing of your data is your consent, and processing is carried out for the following purposes:
9. To improve the browsing experience;
10. To respond to specific requests using information received by contact emails or the completion of forms;
11. To monitor the behaviour of users and modify the provision of content accordingly;
12. **RECIPIENTS OF DATA:** Within the limits pertaining to the purposes indicated, your data may be disclosed to partners, consultancy firms or private companies authorised by the data controller or by law, or to fulfil specific requests made by you. Your data will not be otherwise divulged under any circumstances. The appointed data controllers and data processors are duly identified in the Privacy Statement, which is regularly updated.
13. **TRANSFER OF DATA OVERSEAS:** Data collected may be disclosed to foreign partners of the company for the sole purpose of providing the services requested.
14. **PERIOD OF DATA RETENTION:** Data collected will be retained for a period of time no longer than is necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it is processed (“storage limitation principle”, article 5, GDPR) or in accordance with the expiry dates stipulated by law. Checks are regularly made on the obsolescence of data stored in relation to the purposes for which it collected.

15. **RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT:** The data subject has the right at any time to request from the data controller access to data regarding him or her, the rectification or erasure of such data, restriction on or objection to data processing, and to request the portability of data, to withdraw consent to processing; these and other rights stipulated by the GDPR may be exercised simply by informing the controller. The data subject may also lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
16. **OBLIGATORY NATURE OF CONSENT OR OTHERWISE:** The provision of your data is obligatory during browsing on our website in accordance with points E.1 and E.2 above, in order to ensure correct delivery of its services. However, consent to data processing is optional for point E.3, and failure to provide it will not compromise the provision of services.
17. **METHODS OF DATA PROCESSING:** Personal data provided by you will be processed in accordance with the aforementioned regulation and the privacy obligations undertaken by the controller. Data will be processed using both digital and paper methods and any other suitable medium, in compliance with the appropriate security measures as outlined in article 5, paragraph 1, point f of the GDPR.
